CLEVELAND, Mr. Leroy - Age 86, passed away Saturday, December 23, 2017 at Kith Haven Nursing Home. Family hour 1:30 PM Tuesday, January 2, 2018 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Very quietly and peacefully on Saturday, December 23, 2017, Mr. Leroy Cleveland transitioned to his heavenly rest from earth to glory.

Mr. Leroy Cleveland was born July 10, 1931 in Atlanta, Georgia, the son of Mr. & Mrs. Major and Loucille Cleveland. He attended Philadelphia Public Schools and upon leaving high school in 1948, he enlisted in the United States Army. Leroy served in the Korean War as an Artillery Specialist. He was returned to the states after being injured in Korea and was hospitalized at Valley Forge Military Hospital in Valley Forge, PA until his complete recovery. He was Honorably Discharged in 1952 and shortly thereafter he met our mother, Gloria D. Davis. They were married in July of 1953.

After learning of better employment opportunities Mr. Cleveland moved to

Flint, Michigan where upon arrival immediately began employment at the Buick Foundry and Fisher Body I, divisions of General Motors. He soon transferred to Flint Truck & Bus Assembly, a division of General Motors and remained there as a Relief Welder until his retirement after over 35 years.

Mr. Leroy Cleveland was a member of UAW Local #598, The Vets Club and the Brennan Senior Citizens Center. He was a avid hunter and fisherman. He thoroughly enjoyed sitting on a fish bank and or putting his boat in the water. Even if he didn't catch anything it was a form of relaxation for him. Mr. Cleveland would also go up North to hunt with a group of his friends who loved doing the same; they would also get together for wild game dinner parties, where they would prepare everything from Rabbit, Squirrel, Deer to Possum, Muskrat and Raccoon.
