DISMUKE, Mr. Leroy – Age 71, passed away Sunday, August 2, 2009 at Genesys Regional Medical Center. Family hour 10AM Saturday, August 8, 2009 at St. James CME Church, 310 W. Wood St., where the Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity Memorial Service will be held at 10:30AM, under the auspices of Flint Alumni Chapter, with funeral service commencing immediately at 11AM, Rev. Leroy was born August 18, 1937 in Camden, Arkansas to Roy and Edna Mae (Bragg) Dismuke. Leroy was a graduate of Flint Northern High School. He received his undergraduate degree at Lane College in Education and received his Masters degree in Special Education at Eastern Michigan University. While attending Lane, Leroy met his soul mate Gladys M. Cargle. Leroy and Gladys were united in holy matrimony in 1961. To this union was born a son, Alan Roy Dismuke. Leroy started teaching at Whittier Junior High School in 1960. He became a Special Education teacher in 1964. In 1979, Leroy transferred to an Administration position, as the Special Education Coordinator for the Flint Community Schools. He retired in January of 1991. Leroy was a faithful member of St. James CME Church and he loved spending time with family and close friends. He was an active member of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity. He served as the Exchequer/Treasurer and

served on the Board of Directors of the local Alumni Chapter.
