He counseled many members from Alcoholics Anonymous for 30 years. Leroy "Stack" was an Honorably Discharged Veteran of the United States Army, where he served for 2 years. Leroy retired from General Motors after 34 years of service, and also enjoyed being a crossing guard for the city of Flint for 21 years.
