CAMPBELL, Mr. Lewis - Age 81, passed away Thursday, October 11, 2012 at University of Michigan Hospital-Ann Arbor, MI. Family hour 10 a.m. Thursday, October 18, 2012 at Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church, G-5443 N. Saginaw Street with funeral service commencing at 11 a.m. Bishop Neal Roberson, officiating. Interment River Rest Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the Church 10 a.m. Thursday. Mr. Campbell will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd. and may be viewed from 12 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. Wednesday.

Mr. Lewis Campbell was born February 22, 1931 in Blytheville, Arkansas, the son of William and Mossie Campbell. He received his formal education at Harrison High School in Blytheville. Lewis accepted Christ at an early age and joined St. Paul Missionary Baptist Church in Blytheville. He joined the United States Air Force in 1951 in Muskegon, MI where he received a medal for good conduct. Lewis was Honorably Discharged in 1955. In Muskegon is where he met and married the love of his life, Venita Long on September 29, 1956, and to this union 4 children was born. The couple later relocated to Flint. He was a faithful member of Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church where he served on Usher Board #2 for 40 years. Lewis was employed with General Motors for 31 years before retiring in 1986 and was a member of UAW Local 659. His hobbies included softball, bowling, watching and attending his Detroit Teams,

the Lions, Pistons and Tigers but his special enjoyment was attending Berston Field House to watch his son's play softball or compete against each other. The Lord called Lewis home on October 11, 2012 after 81 years. His life will always be remembered and cherished by his devoted wife: Venita Campbell; 3 sons, Victor (Lori) Campbell, Darrell (Donna) Campbell, all of Flint, Kevin Campbell of Atlanta, GA; 8 grandchildren; 9 great-grandchildren; siblings, Shirley Napoleon of El Dorado, AR, Wilbert (Gertrude) Campbell of Grand Blanc, MI; brother-in-law, Jimmy Jordan of Muskegon, MI; sister-in-law, Bernice Hughes of Memphis, TN; a host of other relatives and friends.

Mr. Campbell was preceded in death by his son, Ronald Campbell; granddaughter, Narhya Dillard, parents, William and Mossie Campbell; sister, Ida Jean Simpson; 5 brothers, Leroy Campbell, Robert Campbell, Melvin Campbell, Auprey Campbell and Andrew Lee Campbell.
