MATTHEWS, Mr. Lewis C., Jr. - Age 87, passed away Saturday October 2, 2010 at Hurley Medical Center. Family hour 10:30 a.m. Saturday, October 9, 2010 at Morning Star Missionary Baptist Church, 2120 N. Saginaw St., with funeral service commencing at 11 a.m., Pastor Keith J. Bigelow officiating. Mr. Lewis Cleophis Matthews, Jr. was born August 30, 1923 in Eudora, Arkansas, to the union of Lewis Columbus and Willie Mae (Royal) Matthews. Lewis was the third of six children. He was a member of Morning Star Missionary Baptist Church, where he served on the Usher Board. He was an Honorably Discharged Korean Conflict Veteran. Lewis retired from Buick Motors, a division of General Motors in 1988 and was a member of UAW Local 599. He loved taking care of his family, tinkering in his garage with small engines and repairing lawn mowers. Mr. Lewis C.
