Sister Lillie Mae Pittman age 82, made her transition from singing in the Macedonia Choirs to singing in the Heavenly Choir on Thursday December 22, 2016 at home in her sleep. She was born January 10, 1934 in Arm, Mississippi, the daughter of the late Deacon Gothea and Mother Mary B. Earl. Lillie accepted Christ at an early age and she began her Christian Journey at the China Lee Baptist Church. After moving to Brookhaven, MS she joined the St. Mark Baptist Church where she sang in the choir. Lillie ended her journey here at Macedonia where she was a member of the Inspirational Voices, the Mass Choir and Sunday School Class Number 6, Sis. Rose Langley was her teacher. Lillie's biggest year was in 1953 when she married her sweetheart the late Luther Pittman. She graduated from Alexander High School and moved to Flint to be with her husband. To this union 3 children were born, Sylvia Dianne, Luther Dewayne and Donald Eric (Dellesa) Pittman. Lillie retired from

Great Giant Supermarket where she was a Clerk and enjoyed every minute of it. She was still in touch with some of the people she met. Lillie enjoyed sewing, doing Crossword Puzzles, baking and cooking. Her nieces want it to be known that she made the best “Hamburgers” in the world. They call them “Lillie Burgers.” We cannot forget that she was an avid Detroit Pistons fan. On Wednesday evening before she passed she said “God’s Grace” by Luther Barnes is my favorite song.

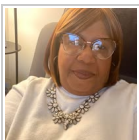
