Minister Linda Barfield was born April 1, 1954 in Flint, Michigan, the daughter of Lucille and Jimmie Barfield Sr. Minister Barfield was a 1972 graduate of Northwestern High School. She loved and lived for her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Minister Barfield was employed as a Medical Radiology Transcriber at the University of Michigan Hospital in Ann Arbor, MI. She later became an Executive Assistant to Joe and Roy Sheraam of Guardian Interlock. She was a member of Believers Bible Christian Church of Atlanta, Georgia, under the leadership of Pastor Allen McNair. Minister Barfield earned her degree in Theology and became a Licensed Minister after graduating with honors as Summa Cum Laude from the School of Ministry Believers Bible College of Atlanta, GA in 1993.
