FLOWERS, First Lady Linda J. - Age 78, passed away Sunday, December 15, 2019 at her residence. Family hour 10:00 AM Saturday, December 21, 2019 at Triumph Church - Flint Campus, 1657 Broadway Blvd., with funeral service commencing at 11:00 AM. Pastor Lawrence Vaughn, officiating. Interment Flint Memorial Park Cemetery, 9506 N. Dort Hwy., Mt. Morris, MI. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10:00 AM Saturday. First Lady Flowers will lie in state at Triumph Church-Flint, and may be viewed from 3:00 PM - 6:00 PM Friday.

A time to weep, a time to laugh, a time to mourn, and a time to dance. We are here today to celebrate the life of a wife, mother, sister, grandmother, aunt, great grandmother and friend, Our Queen, Linda J. Flowers. So that together, we may acknowledge and share our joy in the gift that her life was to us and so many others. Linda was born in Raleigh, NC, on October 7, 1941, the fourth child of six children born to Lum Columbus and Aldonia Blaylock. She was tough as nails and despite being a middle child, she was the first to take up for her siblings. She was educated in the Johnston County school system.

As Linda continued on with her life, she and her daughters relocated to Flint, Michigan. She was a hard working mother to provide for her girls! She worked for the Flint Board of Education as a Home School Counselor. She also retired from Buick City, a division of General Motors Corporation and was a member

of UAW local #599. Linda later went on to become a sought-after Cosmetology Instructor and owned her own Beauty Salon. Linda was a proud and independent woman of many talents and skills! She met Christ at an early age and grew to love the Lord and reading her bible. Linda loved music of all genres and loved to sing! She sung with Herman Robinson and the Community Gospel Travelers.

She later met Pastor James O. Flowers, Sr. and entered into holy matrimony on April 12, 1980. Being the First Lady of North Star M.B. Church, she preferred to simply be called, Linda. She was the Women's Sunday School Teacher, She also taught New Membership Class, sung in the Greater Voices Choir, directed the Inspirational Voices choir, on the Finance Committee, a church secretary and later Facilitator of the Nurses Guild. Linda was so proud of the outreach program, which she founded, that provided food and clothing to those in need. Linda was a breast cancer survivor and sponsored a yearly care-package drive for women cancer patients. She received her bachelor's degree from Truth Bible College in Jacksonville, Florida on May 29, 2004. Over the years she has served in many ministries in the church.

Linda and "J.O." were inseparable. When you saw him, you saw her! Linda also loved having her family together and would look forward to trips with her daughters and grandchildren. There was a lot of love and we know that her legacy will forever live on in all of us. She was an incredible person who inspired everyone who knew her.
