Linzy "Shorty" Williams was born January 30, 1925 in Wesson, Mississippi, the son of Mr. & Mrs. Clark and Missue Furance Williams. Linzy accepted Christ at an early age. He graduated from Hazulhurst High School. Linzy was drafted into the United States Army where he served from 1944-1946 and was Honorably Discharged. He was a World War II Veteran. Linzy moved to Flint, Michigan in 1957, where he was employed by Chevrolet Manufacturing Company, a division of General Motors Corporation and retired after 30 years from AC Rochester West Flint Plant. He was a hunter and loved to go fishing. Linzy was a kind and loving man. He showed great hospitality whenever someone would visit his home. He loved watching sports, talking about his Army days and his days working in the plant and the UAW.

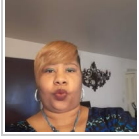
