Lisa graduated from Powers Catholic High School, "Class of 1978." During her Middle and High School years she attended Interlochen Band Camp, participated in the Civitan Club, and was a participant in the Flint Cotillion of 1978. She was an accomplished Flutist, earning First Chair Flute with the American Musical Ambassadors, traveling to nine countries in Europe during the summer of 1978. She attended Michigan State University for almost 3 years. She married Clyde Kelley in 1985. Her life centered around her husband, daughter Amanda and son Clyde Hewston III. She was creative and
