Lloyd joined the U.S. Army in 1943 there he received many medal including the World War II Victory Medal. After leaving the Army, Lloyd made Berkley, CA his home, where he lived with his sister, Bertha, and worked for the United States Post Office. He married Eva Mae Thompson October 1, 1950 from that union four children were born, Royce Edward Hamlin, Mary Marie Hamlin, Rosalyn Hamlin and Romell Hamlin. Lloyd and Eva opened a neighborhood cocktail lounge in Oakland, California. Lloyd and Eva ran the club for many years. Lloyd also worked as a Aircraft Inspector for World Airway. Lloyd loved to play golf and watch old Bible movies. He would love to take long walks and read everything he could find. Lloyd and Eva were married many years, the union came to a end but they both remained very good friends. Lloyd met Terri Whaley in 1969, they were married October 25, 1982. He soon retired from World Airway in 1986.

Lloyd and Terri ran the neighborhood bar together there they met many good friends because Lloyd did not meet any enemies unless you spoke negative about his wife. Lloyd was kind and would give you his last, often to people who never paid him back and many people took advantage of this. Lloyd would always say they will need me again, do not get mad just make sure when you do lend do not expect it back. His famous words were I just bought him for \$20.00 bucks. Many people thought they knew Lloyd, they were wrong. Lloyd was funny and he could crack on you faster than lighting, without cracking a smile. He was so funny. Lloyd was diagnosed with Alzheimer's Disease late 2000, he did well until he was struck by a hit and run driver in the summer of 2004. With this Lloyd and his wife moved to Flint, Michigan to be with family for she needed much help.
