Lois Thrash, culinarian, gardener, hat-lover and social butterfly was born on June 25, 1918 in LaGrange Georgia, the daughter of Charlie and Alberta (Cameron) Freeman. She was married to Joseph Thrash for over 60 years and had four children. Lois moved to Flint, Michigan in 1944 and worked at Art Craft Press. She became a member of Mt. Olive Missionary Baptist Church in 1945 and served the congregation as the Vice-President of the Bereavement Club, member of the Floral Club member of the Missionary. Etched in memory is the taste of her corn-bread dressing, homemade rolls, and infamous caramel cake. If you were fortunate enough to receive a Mason Jar of Lois' chow-chow, made with green tomatoes from her garden, you were loved. Lois enjoyed talking on the phone to her sister and friends, and traveling to her family reunions and to Las Vegas.
