LEE, Mrs. Lola M. (Luster) - Age 97, peacefully went home to be with the Lord, Tuesday, June 30, 2009 at Triumph Hospital in Detroit, MI, surrounded by her family and friends. Family hour 10:45AM Friday, July 10, 2009 at Foss Avenue Baptist Church, 1159 E. Foss Ave., with funeral service commencing at 11:30AM, Rev. Dr. Henry L. Fuller, Jr. officiating. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 4PM-8PM Thursday. Mrs. Lola M. Luster Lee was born September 11, 1911 in Lincoln County, Arkansas, the daughter of Anderson and Jennett Luster. Mrs. Lee accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized at Bethlehem No. 2 Baptist Church in Tarry, Arkansas. There she served as a faithful and active member of the Church until she moved to Flint, Michigan in 1968. Later she joined Foss Avenue Baptist Church, where she was a long time member until she began to experience ill health and was no longer able to attend. Mrs. Lee attended the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff formerly AM&N College. She later taught school until she married and started a family. When she returned to the workforce she assisted her brother in several capacities in his business. Mrs. Lee had a solid religious stronghold and was a believer in education.
