DENT, Mr. Louis Calvin "Dent" - Age 64, passed away Monday, June 4, 2012 at Hurley Medical Center. Family hour 10 a.m. Monday, June 11, 2012 at Canaan Baptist Church, 910 E. Gillespie St., with funeral service commencing at 11 a.m. Pastor Charles E. Roots, officiating. Interment Sunset Hills Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10 a.m. Monday. Mr. Dent will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 10 a.m.-6 p.m. Sunday. Bro. Louis Calvin "Teenie" Dent was born December 28, 1947, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Obie Lee, Sr. and Cora B. (Fonville) Dent. He was a resident of Flint for more than 50 years. Louis graduated from Flint Northern High School, "Class of 1966", where he was active in wrestling, track and football. According the Coach Fred Crawford, "Louis Dent was one of the best offensive ends Northern has had in a lot of years." Coach Soffredine commented, "Louis was a real leader and a hard worker." He worked at the St. Louis Housing Commission until his illness. Louis was an avid fisherman and loved all sports. "Teenie" was well loved by his family and friends. He brought joy to all his nieces and nephews and was well loved. Louis was also an artist and could draw very well.
