Mr. Louis Calvin McLilly Sr. was born January 7, 1934 in Dubach, Louisiana to Lawrence and Rosie McLilly. On January 10, 1953, Louis united in Holy Matrimony with the woman who would become the love of his life, Ms. Catherine Ford. Later that year they relocated to Flint, Michigan to begin their life and family together. Mr. McLilly worked tirelessly for 55 years with General Motors Service Parts Organization (SPO) as a member of Local 659.

Mr. McLilly greatly enjoyed spending time with family and friends, cruising around town in his mobile home, sitting on his porch to watch over the neighborhood, and listening to music. His gifted James Brown dance moves were often the highlight of any family gathering or special event.
