Mrs. Luchrista "Chris" Crawford was born February 26, 1933 in White, Georgia, one of nine children born to Mr. & Mrs. Will and Lucy Carreker of Nelson, GA. "Chris" was called home on Saturday, April 23, 2016. She passed away peacefully at her home. "Chris" was the beloved wife of the late Mr. William H. Crawford, Sr. She was a graduate of Fort Valley State College. After marrying William, the couple moved to Flint in 1958. "Chris" was a School Teacher for the Flint Community School District, retiring after 36 years. She taught at Martin Elementary and later at Potter Elementary. One of her favorite sayings was "You cannot change the past, but you can influence your future!" "Chris" loved all of her students and did her best to involve them in drama and talent shows. She was known among her colleagues for her exceptional poetic and dramatic writings. One of "Chris" proudest achievements was an Honorary Literary Award given to her from the Montel

Williams Show.
