WILLIAMS, Mr. Lucious - Age 92, passed away Sunday, December 17, 2006 at Kith Haven Nursing Home. Family hour 10:30AM Friday, December 22, 2006 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., with funeral service commencing immediately at 11AM. Rev. Jeffery Wheeler officiating. Entombment Flint Memorial Park Cemetery, G-9506 N. Dort Hwy. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the funeral home 10:30AM Friday. Mr. Williams will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, and may be viewed from 1PM-8PM Thursday. Mr. Lucious Williams was born October 15, 1914 in Pitken, Arkansas, the son of Port Lee and Hulda Williams. He attended school in Pitken, AR, later moving to Dumas, AR to look for work. He met and married Ida Swopes on January 31, 1941 and relocated to New Haven, CN. Lucious was drafted in the United States Army, serving from 1943 until 1946. He received many decorations and citations including the World War II Victory Ribbons, the Good Conduct Medal, three Bronze Service Stars and the Philippine Liberation Ribbon before being Honorably Discharged. Mr. Williams moved back to Dumas, AR before settling in Flint. He began working at General Motors in 1953 and was employed for 29 years, retiring in 1982. He was a member of UAW Local #599. Lucious loved fishing, gardening and spending time with family. Mr. Lucious Williams leaves to cherish his memory: son, David Ransom Williams; 6 grandchildren, David L. Williams of Flint, Vallery Crump of Cincinnati, OH, Derrek, Mark and Kimberly Williams, all of Flint and Tiffany Williams of Mionrow, OH; many other

relatives and friends including Betty Goodman, Juanita Battles, James Hill, Glen Thompson and the Simmons, Webb, White and Smith families.
