AUBREY, Ms. Lula - Age 93, passed away Sunday, March 29, 2026 in Burton, MI. Family hour 10:00 AM Monday, April 6, 2026, at St. Paul Missionary Baptist Church, 2115 W. Mrs. Lula Aubrey passed away peacefully and went home to be with the Lord on Sunday, March 29, 2026, at the age of 92, 1.5 hours before her 93rd birthday. Lula was born March 30, 1933, in St. Joseph, Louisiana, the daughter of Issac and Barbara McDaniel. She attended St. Joseph High School and graduated in the "Class of 1950." Lula worked at Yankee Department Store from 1966-1972, afterwards she hired into General Motors Corporation, retiring in 1999. Lula was a member of UAW Local #659. She was currently among the oldest members of St. Paul Missionary Baptist Church with a tenure of 70 years of service. Lula was a devoted follower of Christ as she personified her love for Him. Lula taught Sunday School for many years and was formerly Sunday School Superintendent. She faithfully sang in the Choir for more than 50 years until her health began to fail. Lula served Christ whole heartedly and led an example to all as she followed the

footsteps of Christ.

Lula took time out for an elaborate vacation as she set sail on tour cruises to many extravagant parts of the world with friends and family. She was affiliated with Eastern Star Jurisdiction of Michigan with many honors; Lifetime Member, Past Worthy Matron (Chapter 27) that began on March 18, 1968.
