Mae Della (Brown) Green was born April 2, 1940, the eldest child of Melton and Alice (Moore) Brown in Williamston, North Carolina. She moved to Flint, Michigan at the age of five. Mae was a graduate of Flint Central High School. She earned an Associate Degree from Mott Community College. Mae went on

to earn a Bachelor's Degree and a Master's Degree from Eastern Michigan University. She was an honor student at each level of her education. On March 21, 1964, Mae married Victor T. Green and to this union, they were blessed with two children, Victor Jr. and Bethany Green. At a young age, Mae joined Vermont Christian Church where she was a devoted and active member. She has been involved with tutoring, the Scholarship Committee, Women's Fellowship, Deaconess, Treasurer and a member of the choir. Mae truly loved to worship God. Mae was employed as a Mathematics Teacher in the Flint Community Schools. She taught at Bryant Junior High School, Holmes Junior High School and Northern High School. Mae enjoyed helping students and understood the impact that education and a caring teacher could have on the lives of students. After retiring in 1992, she taught part-time at the Detroit College of Business. Mae was also a member of Phi Delta Kappa, a Professional Organization for Educators. Mae was Lifetime Member of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority Inc. She pledged Delta Beta in 1960. Mae was the first scholarship recipient and has been honored with a scholarship in her name. In 2009, Mae was a Midwest Alumnae Soror of the Year Nominee. During her membership, she has served as Chairperson of an Internal Audit, Treasurer and Corresponding Secretary and has been a Financial Member since initiation. During her free time, Mae helped low income families complete their taxes, volunteered with the Helping One Student To Succeed Reading Program, was a member of the African American Quilters Guild, enjoyed sewing and knitting, exercising, traveling and spending time with family. Mae will be remembered as a patient, humble, quiet, caring, kind, sympathetic, loving, encouraging, strong willed, even tempered, happy, peaceful and giving wife, mother, sister and grandmother who gladly sacrificed for the good of her family. She lived and loved life to the fullest, even during the most difficult and trying times without a single complaint.

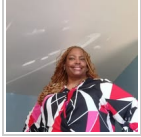
