WHITE, Mr. Major - Age 91, passed away Sunday, May 7, 2017 at Willowbrook Manor. Family hour 10:30 AM Friday, May 12, 2017 at Southeast Christian Church of the Apostolic Faith, 4171 Lapeer Rd., Burton, MI., with funeral service commencing at 11:00 AM District Elder Kenneth Melvin Brown Sr., officiating. Bro. Major L. White "Bunch" was born July 6, 1925 in El Dorado, Arkansas, the son of Sylvester and Carrie (Maker) White. He was a member of Bethlehem Temple and Southeast Christian Church. Major loved his jobs; some of them were, cutting grass; he was a perfectionist about his grass. He would let you know "Stay off my Grass"; his famous punch; he loved to Usher and was Vice Chairman for a number of years; ushering was his heart, the famous quote was "If every usher was just like me, what would the usher board be"; cleaning and doing lawn care for the church; cleaning building, and physician offices; he was also known for his BBQ. One of the most important parts of Major was that he was very meticulous about how he looked. Major was a Veteran of the United States Army; he retired from General Motors after 36 years of service. One of his favorite phrases is "be good, be good and be

good". In 1950 he heard the call and was baptized in Jesus name and received the gift of the Holy Ghost under the late District Elder B.T. Scott. He was part of the Senior Choir and led a song "I'm Going Through."
