He then began his career at General Motors Truck Assembly, Chevrolet Manufacturing, and Pontiac Metal Fabricating for the next 31 years, retiring from UAW Local 653. Marcus was affiliated with the United States Bowling Congress and The National Bowling Congress for a number of years, bowling in several leagues at Northwest, Town and Country, and Fiero Lanes.
