CONYERS-HOLMES, Ms. Mardese Therese - Age 51, passed away Tuesday, January 20, 2009 at McLaren Regional Medical Center. Family hour 10AM Saturday, January 24, 2009 at Grace Emmanuel Baptist Church, 3502 Lapeer Rd., with funeral service commencing at 11AM, Pastor Marvin A. Jennings, Sr., officiating. Interment New Calvary Catholic Cemetery, G-4142 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10AM Saturday. Ms. Conyers-Holmes will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12Noon-8PM Friday. Ms. Mardese Therese Conyers-Holmes was born February 15, 1957 in Flint, Michigan. She was a resident of Flint and a member of Grace Emmanuel Baptist Church. Mardese was a graduate of Southwestern High School "Class of 1975", received her Associate Degree from Mott Community College, her Bachelor Degree of Arts from Spring Arbor College, and her latest educational achievement a Master's Degree in Social Work from Michigan State University; which she completed with honors on May 4, 2007 and received her (LLMSW) License in Social Work from the State of Michigan. Mardese was an employee of the General Motors Corporation (GM) since 1979. She received a certificate for 25 years of loyal and dedicated service. Mardese worked at Buick City on the assembly line, she was accepted in the GM skilled-trades apprentice program and received her Journeyman certification in Air Condition and Refrigeration in 1990. In 1999, Mardese was then blessed to receive a position at the UAW-GM Center for

Human Resources in Detroit, Michigan; where she was recently held an International Appointment of Special Assignment. Mardese was affiliated with numerous organizations including a loyal and active member of UAW Local 599; in which she served on various committees. She was a proud and dedicated member of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated- Flint Alumnae Chapter. She was a member of Grace Emmanuel Baptist Church Mass Choir, NAACP, volunteered for years with the United Negro College Fund and was accepted as a member of Phi Alpha National Social Work Honor Society.
