She was employed by Hamady Brothers as a meat cutter for 22 years and retired in 1984. She was an active member of the local meat cutters union and VFW Women's Auxiliary. Mrs. Hayden was a faithful member of Christ Fellowship Baptist Church and enjoyed singing with "The Voices of Christ Fellowship", attending Sunday school class #10 and Wednesday evening bible class.
