Mrs. Margaret Lee (Bailey-Miller) Lane was born on May 17, 1941 in Columbus, Mississippi to Mr. Leo Bailey and the late Mrs. Stare Lee (Kennedy) Bailey. Margaret was raised by her father and grandparents in a well-mannered and religious home. She attended public schools in Columbus where she had many friends. Margaret confessed her faith in the Lord at an early age and was baptized in the King Cage Creek. She joined the Mt. Avery Missionary Baptist Church, under the leadership of the late Rev. B.T. Wilson. Margaret was fun and loving to her sister. They were like two peas in a pod. When you saw one, the other was not far away. That is the way they grew up, they did everything together. Mr. Bailey taught them to drive a column-shift at the ages of 10 and 11. The two of them had a beautiful relationship, being taught to never turn their back on each other. Margaret married and relocated to Chicago, IL for a short period of time and later returned to Columbus because she did not like Chicago. In 1971, she moved to Flint, MI where she lived with her sister for a short period of

time. She was a member of different churches during her time in Flint, her memberships included, St. Paul Missionary Baptist Church, Galilee Baptist Church, and a faithful member of New Life Baptist Church, under the leadership of Pastor Wilbert Campbell until her health failed her.
