Gail loved her nieces and nephews, and they loved her back, each one was held close to her heart. Her nurturing spirit, love and care extended far beyond family. She was a longtime member of Woodside Church, where she lovingly served in the children's nursery for many years. She was a comforting presence to neighborhood children and anyone in need of a kind smile. Gail lived a life rooted in love and service. She gave from the depths of her soul—never asking for recognition, always giving from the heart. Miss.
