HATCHETT, Mrs. Marie S. - age 89, passed away Sunday, April 13, 2014 at Regency at Grand Blanc-Grand Blanc, MI. Family hour 10:30 a.m. Saturday, April 19, 2014 at Saints of God Ministries, 528 W. Pierson Rd. with funeral service commencing at 11 a.m. Pastor Alfred Harris officiating. Interment Sunset Hills Association, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the Church 10:30 a.m. Saturday. Mrs. Hatchett will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd. and may be viewed from 3 p.m.-8 p.m. Friday, with the family present from 4 p.m.-6 p.m.

Mrs. Marie Hatchett was born December 1, 1924 in Valley, Mississippi, the daughter of Herbert and Carrie Suttlar. Marie was a resident of Mt. Morris, MI where she was a devoted caregiver for her daughter before becoming ill March 1, 2014. For over 60 years, Marie was a faithful member of Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church and a member of the Senior Choir. In 2010 she joined the Saints of God Church family. In previous years, Marie was active in the Flint community, NAACP, Urban League, Democratic Black Caucus and Dewey School Women's Club. Marie retired from the Flint Board of Education after working with children for 14 years.
