Mrs. Marilyn Louise (Williams) Hill was born June 4, 1939 in Chidester, Arkansas to the late David and Charlotte Williams. Marilyn graduated from Flint Northern High School, Class of 1958, and then went to pursue her love for cosmetology at Star Beauty School. She loved to brainstorm new styles and participated in many style shows. On June 2, 1960 Marilyn married Lofton W. Hill and they shared 35 years together until his death. To their union 3 children were born. Marilyn worked at Boyd's Style-O-Rama and later worked in the family beauty salon in her parent's basement. Marilyn later became employed at General Motors Truck & Bus, where she was employed for 25 years. Aside from working and providing for her family, Marilyn loved to cook, decorate, play cards, fish and had an incredible passion for fashion and working in the yard.
