



Mother Martha Richardson Harrison

August 15, 1928 - March 2, 2019

HARRISON, Mother Martha Richardson - Age 90, passed away Saturday, March 2, 2019 at her residence. Funeral Service 11:00 AM Saturday, March 9, 2019 at Mount Sinai Missionary Baptist Church, 1215 E. Downey St., Pastor Morris Collins, Host Pastor, Pastor Ira G. Edwards, Officiating. Interment Sunset Hills Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the Church 10:30 AM Saturday. Mother Harrison will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 1:00 PM-8:00 PM Friday, with family present to receive friends from 4:00 PM-6:00 PM.

Mother Martha Richardson Harrison was born on August 15, 1928 in Columbia, South Carolina. She was the eldest of seven children born to Samuel and Clara Rose Richardson. Raised in a devoutly Christian home, Martha accepted Christ at an early age and aspired to live for Him. Mother Harrison graduated from Booker T. Washington High School in Columbia, South Carolina and then attended Benedict College where she met her future husband, Samuel B. Harrison. After two years at Benedict, she entered the Good Samaritan-Waverly Hospital Nursing School. Graduating in 1950, she and her close friend, Margie Rembert, left Columbia, South Carolina to work in Memphis, Tennessee at John Gaston Hospital. After a year in Tennessee, they headed to Stockton, California to work at San Joaquin County Hospital. After a few months in California, Mother Martha Harrison left to join her

husband in Clarksdale, Mississippi where she worked at Cohoma County Hospital. In 1963, Samuel and Martha Harrison, along with their two children, left Mississippi to relocate in Flint, Michigan. Mother Martha Harrison was one of the first full-time African-American Registered Nurses to work at the Flint Osteopathic Hospital where she retired after over 20 years of service.

Mother Martha Richardson Harrison lived a full life. She was a career woman, wife, mother, sister, friend, but most of all, a child of God. She loved taking care of her family, working in the garden, being active in church, and reading her Bible. Mother Harrison was a gracious woman who exemplified the description of a virtuous woman found in Proverbs 31 and those who had the opportunity to know her will attest to her kind and gentle spirit.

Harrison of Flint, Michigan; one grand-daughter, Elizabeth Breonna Harrison and daughter-in-law, Anita Harrison of Lansing, Michigan; god-daughter, Tyree Moore of Mt. Morris, Michigan; one sister, Robena Blackford of Washington, DC; three brothers, Samuel (Gwen) Richardson, Jr., and Dr. William (Josephine) Richardson of Columbia, South Carolina; Dr. Thomas (Rosie) Richardson, Durham, North Carolina; god-sister, Maggie Fields of Clarksdale, Mississippi; a host of nieces and nephews and special friends, Mrs. Margie Rembert of Stockton, California and Sis. Nellie Cole of Flint, Michigan.

Harrison; parents, Samuel and Clara Rose Richardson; sisters, Nina Blocker and Jessie Brooks; mother- and father-in-law, Andrew and Rosa Harrison; sisters-in-law, Susie Stern and Ernestine Davis; brothers-in-law, Harold Blackford, Jimmie Blocker, Clarence Brooks, Henry Davis, and Andrew Harrison; and other relatives.
