Monroe, Mrs. Martha M. "Sue" (Eason) - age 91, passed away Wednesday, April 23, 2014 at her residence. Family hour 11am Tuesday, April 29, 2014 at Antioch Missionary Baptist Church, 1083 E. Martha Maxine "Sue" (Eason) Monroe was born on January 27, 1923, in Marianna, AR, the daughter of Jordan and Ruby (Chatters) Eason. Martha moved to Flint, MI in 1945 and was employed by General Motors for 30 years. She united with Antioch Missionary Baptist Church where she was an active member for almost 60 years serving on the Usher Board, in the Choir, the Mission, and on the Kitchen Committee. Martha was a diligent and willing worker until her health failed. Her hobbies were quilting, and crocheting. She loved traveling and cooking for friends and family. Martha was an awesome cook! Her peach cobbler, made from peaches she canned, was the bomb! She made homemade ice cream, German chocolate cake, melt in your mouth rolls, and I can't forget the sweet potato pies! A little more time should have been spent with her in the kitchen. She was a Christian who really loved and trusted the Lord. Mrs. Monroe was a strong mother who ran a tight ship; she

did not spare the rod. She said what she meant, and she meant what she said. She taught others to be honest, respectful, hard working, and to love the Lord. She demanded a lot but she gave a lot. If she could help you, she would, and nobody would ever hear about it. Anyone who knew her knew she was one of a kind. Martha loved to dress and look good especially for church. She did not consider herself dressed for church without a hat to match her outfit.

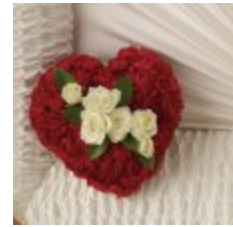
