CHANDLER, Sister Martine - Age 73, passed away Saturday, May 28, 2005 at her residence. Family hour 11AM Saturday, June 4, 2005 at Antioch Missionary Baptist Church, 1083 E. Stewart Ave., with funeral service commencing at 12Noon with Pastor Lewis Randolph officiating. Interment Sunset Hills Cemtery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 11AM Saturday. Mrs. Chandler will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12Noon-8PM Friday. Sister Martine ("Tina") C. Chandler was born on July 5, 1931, in East St. Louis, Illinois, to the union of Lee and Bertha Brown. Sister Chandler graduated from Lincoln High School and then completed a two-year program in business. While working in her hometown, she met and married I.V. Chandler and, shortly thereafter, relocated to Flint. Mr. Chandler ultimately became the owner of his own asphalt paving company. Sister Chandler was employed at Hurley Medical Center, where she retired after 25 years of dutiful and revered service and accomplishment. Three (3) children were born to the Chandler union: Kveta Denise Howell (Gregory) of Mt. Vernon, NY, Tina Trenice Posey (Stephen) of Rochester Hills, MI, and Ivory Chandler II (Deanne) of Anthem, AZ. Around 1955, Sister Chandler became a member of the Antioch Missionary Baptist Church ("ABC"). Over the past thirty (30) years, she has been an active and outspoken ABC member, parishioner and matriarch, while serving on, pioneering and leading various ABC auxiliaries, committees, boards and

departments. Consequently, and inevitably, Sister Chandler's acclaim and notoriety in both the church and general communities became, and still is, locally and widely renowned. When Sister Chandler spoke, people listened, and her piercing, wisdom-filled words were heeded. In all, Sister Chandler was a very special and remarkable Saint, wife, mother, relative, friend, and child of God. Sister Chandler departed to Glory on Saturday, May 28, 2005.
