Mary was affectionately called "Maw Maw" by all her grands and great-grands. Mary will always be remembered for her consistent firmness. She didn't sugar coat anything but was very direct when communicating. Mary B. Roman enjoyed traveling and one of her favorite places to travel was to Georgia.
