TYLER, Mrs. Mary P. - Age 87, passed away Wednesday, January 14, 2009 at her residence. Family hour 10AM Wednesday, January 21, 2009 at Charity United Methodist Church, 4601 Clio Rd., with funeral service commencing immediately at 11AM, Dr. Hydrian Elliott officiating. Interment Flint Memorial Park Cemetery, G-9506 N. Dort Hwy. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10AM Wednesday. Mrs. Tyler will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, and may be viewed from 12Noon-8PM Tuesday. Mrs. Mary Palestine Tyler was born August 2, 1921 in Fredonia, Kentucky, the daughter of Charles and Wessie (Harris) Scott. Mary grew up in Kentucky and Indiana, where she met and later married Charles Tyler in 1943. They moved to Flint, Michigan in 1946, where she raised her large family. She attended Flint Park Methodist Church and Charity United Methodist Church. After the birth of her last child, she became employed at Hurley Hospital, retiring from there in 1984. Her hobbies prior to a stroke she suffered in 2002 included sewing, gardening, reading and playing cards with her husband (particularly winning). She was an excellent cook. She was a one-of-a-kind mother who did very little for herself, and everything for her family. Mary enjoyed the music of the Big Band Era as well as more modern artists, particularly Whitney Houston.
