Mary Ann Williams was born April 5, 1930 in Lansing, Michigan, the daughter of Emanuel R. Parker III and Mary Polly Williams. Mary Ann came to Flint in 1932, where she united with Blackwell AME Zion Church and confessed Christ at a very young age. She joined Shiloh M.B. Church of Flint in July 1954. While at Shiloh, she was a member of the Trustee Board, Eleanor Allen Choraliers (EAC's) and the Birthday Club. Sis.
