YOUNG, Mother Mary E. - Age 80, passed at away at Friday, September 13, 2013 at McLaren-Flint. Family hour 10:30 a.m. Saturday, September 21, 2013 at New Jerusalem Full Gospel Baptist Church, 1035 E. Carpenter Rd., with funeral service commencing at 11 a.m. Pastor Patrick Sanders, Sr., officiating. Interment Sunset Hills Association, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10:30 a.m. Saturday. Mother Young will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12 noon-8 p.m. Friday.

On a warm day, June sixth, nineteen hundred and thirty-three, in Huntsville, Alabama, a swift movement of love took place and Charlie and Sophia Calhoun became the parents of MARY ELIZABETH. Mary was the third child in this family.

Her parents, one daughter, Peggy, and three of her five siblings preceded her in death, Emma, Charlie Jr., and M.C.

It is said that from the moment that "Wootsy", began walking it was with speed and intent. Mary was small in stature but even in her hometown as a very young woman, she entered the place with a big flair. While Mary was coming through the bushes, they said, "The bushes would swagger, rustle, and sway, because Wootsy, always had a switch." You knew she had arrived.

Mary could be heard boldly declaring, "O taste and see that the LORD is good."

Mary Elizabeth sashayed into love and married Herman Young. Leaving Detroit they traveled to Flint, Michigan where they shared their love with seven children: Carl, Beverly, Brenda, Timothy, Charles, Darryl and Tara. Herman Charles (Sammy) and son, Timothy preceded her in death.

Mary was fun loving, full of jokes, and loved to reminisce about growing up with her siblings. She lived with memories of family fun. Whenever possible, we all, sisters, brothers, nieces, nephews, children, grandchildren, great grandchildren, neighbors and friends would gather around to listen to her stories. She often reminded those who were present that she may have grown up with little material wealth, but there was no lack of LOVE. Her greatest desire was that all of her family would be close and live in the grace of God's love. Mary was a LOVER, in every sense of the word.

Mary Elizabeth Young, as she would say, "stepped into High Cotton," on September 13, 2013.
