She received her Bachelor Degree from Lincoln University. Prior to completing her degree, she worked at Hurley Medical Center (Hurley Hospital). As a young teen, she also worked in her uncle's gas station and was trained to do every aspect of the job, including pumping gas. As a teacher, Mattie was dedicated to her students. She worked in schools throughout the Flint area in elementary, junior and some senior high schools as a Substitute Teacher. After 30 years, she retired but went back as a Substitute Teacher in Elementary, Junior High and High schools throughout the district when needed. Mattie loved to dance, cook and go clothes shopping. She also enjoyed traveling with friends and spending time in Idlewild, MI with the Johnson's. In 2022, Mattie was awarded a certificate honoring her as the "Matriarch for the McIntyre Linage." she was the oldest living female and received a Certificate at the McIntyre Family Reunion, organized by Mrs.

Sharron (McIntyre) Gibson and committee.
