Mrs. Mattie Lee Malone was born December 7, 1927 in Winston-Salem, North Carolina, the daughter of Clarence and Maggie (Amaker) Thomas. She lived in North Carolina until the age of sixteen when she moved to Flint. Mattie attended Flint Community Schools and graduated from Flint Northwestern High School. Later, she was hired at AC Spark Plug, a division of General Motors. Her employment there afforded her the opportunity to further her education. Mattie received a degree in Business Administration, a certificate in Computer Communications Technology, both from Mott Community College and a Bachelor Degree in Sociology from the University of Michigan-Flint. She also received Master Degree credits from Detroit Mercy College in Education which certified her to teach. Mattie was baptized at King Solomon Missionary Baptist Church and later joined Grace Emmanuel Baptist Church working on the Senior Citizens Ministry and the Scholarship Committee. After retiring from AC Spark Plug (Delphi Energy and Management) she became involved in

education and begun her career as a Substitute Teacher with emotional mentally impaired and handicapped students. Mattie belonged to various other organizations including a Life Member of the NAACP and the University of Michigan-Flint Alumnae. She served on the Mayor's City Wide Advisory Board, Representative of Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority Delta Chapter, the United Teachers of Flint Executive Board including serving several terms as Vice President for the Flint Board of Education Substitute Teachers and American Business Women's Association Nu Lite Chapter.

She is survived by: grandsons, Kelvin Cobb and Ricky Grigsby, both of Flint; great-grandchildren, Lakeshia Cobb, Karell Cobb, Danyla Scott and Daijah Scott; a host of nieces and nephews including, Owen (Jean) Jackson, Evit Coleman, Arlean Jackson and Tanya Coleman; god-daughter, Alfredia Wingate; god-son, Gerald Turner.

Mrs. Malone was preceded in death by her daughter, Lynda Cobb-Griffin; granddaughter, La Kesha Cobb; parents, Clarence and Maggie Thomas; three sisters, Patricia Ford, Angela Wilson and Mary Jackson; two aunts, Aline Parks and Marie Robertson.
