Maudine was a very spiritual woman of God, who accepted Christ in her life at the early age of 12 and has been faithfully committed to the church since. Maudine was a homemaker who enjoyed raising her children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren. Always a devoted wife and mother in agreement with her husband they reared their children in the fear and admonition of God. They strongly believed in Proverbs 22:6, which says: "Train up a child in the way he

should go and when he is old he will not depart from it". She was also a surrogate mother to many. Her family and others affectionately called her "Madear". Maudine loved her family dearly and her love showed through her home cooking.
