BUTLER, Mrs. Mazie Mae - Age 92, passed away Wednesday, May 29, 2019 at her residence. Family hour 10:30 AM Monday June 10, 2019 at Cathedral of Faith COGIC, 6031 Dupont St., with funeral service commencing at 11:30 AM, Supt. Chris Martin, officiating. Interment Great Lakes National Cemetery, G-4200 Belford Rd., Holly, MI. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the Church 10:30 AM Monday. Mrs. Butler will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 10:00 AM-6:00 PM with family present to receive friends from 3:00 PM-5:00 PM Sunday.

Mazie Watt Butler was the fourth of ten children, born to Rubie M. and Emmitt Watt, October 3, 1926. At the age of 18, Mazie married John McKeown in Mississippi. They moved to Detroit, Michigan with two small children, seeking better job opportunities for their growing family. After dissolution of the marriage, Mazie pursued a career in nursing to provide for their children. The children spent time with their Grandparents in Mississippi for the summer, while she pursued her dream of becoming a Licensed Practical Nurse.

Mazie was a beautiful caregiver to her younger siblings. Her home was considered an anchor, as family members migrated to Detroit. Her home was always filled with wonderfully prepared food, and considered a place of safety. Mazie worked for Flint General Hospital, the Post Office, and she retired from

Genesee Memorial Hospital in Flint, Michigan. Mazie married James Jackson and helped to raise his 4 small boys. That marriage ended after 22 years and she returned to Mississippi, where she reconnected with her first love, Mr. Bennie Butler. Their home was located just out of town on several acres of land, where Mazie was instrumental in building a subsidized fishing pond, which was dug and stocked. While this business was thriving, she worked as a visiting nurse for the Starkville Health Department at Mississippi State University. This marriage ended suddenly with the death of her husband. She remained in Mississippi, for several years and provided care for her aging parents before she decided to return to Michigan to be near her children.
