Michael affectionately known as "Boo" loved God, his family and sports. He was a member of Father In Jesus Christ Church. Michael specifically was a huge fan of basketball and considered by many a basketball legend in his own right. "Boo" was a graduate of Flint Southwestern High School "Class of 1982", where he was a three letterman athlete, playing varsity basketball, football and track. He also attended Flint Central High School his junior year and was a member of their 1981 State Championship Basketball Team. After high school, he attended and played basketball at Catonsville College in Maryland. "Boo" attended several All-American Basketball Camps including the famous All-American Five Star Camp, where he won Most Valuable Player Accolades.
