Mr. Michael Kimbrough was born September 6, 1969 at Hurley Medical Center; to the proud parents of Barbara Marie and Sammie Lee Kimbrough. Michael was a lifelong resident of the city of Flint and attended the Flint Community Schools graduating from Flint Northern High School, "Class of 1988." Although, employed in various areas of work to provide for his families mainly engaged in two major areas.

Early on he worked in the health care profession for several years, where he was very passionate and engaged with his patients. For the last ten years he worked in the automotive industry with Android Industries as a heavy equipment operator.
