He is the oldest child of the union between Theola (Massey) Oliver and the late Bobbie L. Oliver. Michael attended Flint Public Schools and was a member of the Boy Scouts of America. Michael was a drum major for the Flint Northern Vikings Marching Band, where he graduated in 1975 with distinguished honors. He continued his education at Michigan State University and pursued a career in Law Enforcement., becoming a Michigan State Trooper for 25 years. Michael worked with the K-9 unit retiring in 2005.
