On December 23, 1942 Mother Mildred Louise Lockett was born to Mildred and Zeb Lockett in Burstell Arkansas. She was the 4th child of 9 sisters and brothers. She accepted the Lord at a early age, and attend St. Clair Baptist Church where she was the secretary of Sunday school. She graduated from Simmons High School in Okolona Arkansas where she was an outstanding basketball player. She worked for Levi Jean Company while she attended Henderson State University. In 1966 she moved to Flint, Michigan, where she met and married Albert L. Dudley Sr. together they have 9 children, 27 grandchildren and 8 great-grandchildren and counting. She was married 40 years until her husband death in 2006.

Mildred attended Walton School for wedding planning and cake decorating. In addition, she attended Mott Community College for Business Management.

Further, she worked for several years as a Nursing Assistant at Clara Barton Nursing Home, later working at McLaren Hospital as a Dietitian Aid and in the bakery as a Baker at Meijers. Mildred started her own business called Eriuniqu'e Designs in 1998 in which was named after her granddaughter. She planned, designed, and catered all 5 of her daughter's weddings. Our mother was talented, smart and crafty. She designed flower arrangements and centerpieces, wedding cakes, specialty baskets, prom courage and was a seamstress.

She loved the outdoors; we would always go camping, fishing and sightseeing. Our family would pack up and travel to Arkansas and Georgia at least twice a year. In Michigan, on the weekends and holidays we would travel up north to see different points of interest. My mother was a world traveler, they vacationed in Canada, Alaska, Bahamas, Cancun, and many more. Our mother was a big sports fan; she loved and supported the Beecher Bucs. She attended every football and basketball game she could. She loved her children very much. She supported them in anything they wanted to do. Our mother acted as a mentor to her grandchildren, niece, nephew and friends. Mother Mildred L. Dudley was a beautiful soul of giving. Her spirit will leave a long lasting legacy for her family. Her kindness and warm heart is felt deeply among her family and friends. She will be sadly missed, but her love will carry on forever.
