Campbell, Dea. Milton - Age 52, passed away Friday, November 15, 2013 in Indianapolis, Indiana at his residence. Family hour 11:30a.m. Saturday, November 24, 2013 at Mt. Dea. Milton Campbell was born November 9, 1961, in Flint, MI. He was the son of the late Cassander and Dorothy (Comer) Campbell. Dea. Campbell confessed Christ at an early age at the Mt. Sinai Missionary Baptist Church where he served faithfully under the late Pastor J.C. Montgomery until he relocated to Indianapolis. After his move to Indianapolis, he united with the New Fellowship Family Church where he served faithfully as a deacon.
