



## Mr. Morris Johnson

June 3, 1937 - June 11, 2013

JOHNSON, Mr. Morris - Age 78, passed away Tuesday, June 11, 2013 at Fostrian Manor. Family hour 11 a.m. Saturday, June 15, 2013 at North Central Church of Christ, 2001 N. Saginaw St., with funeral service commencing at 12 noon. Minister Rigel Dawson officiating. Interment Lovedale Memorial Cemetery, G-5175 E. Bristol Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 11 a.m. Saturday. Mr. Johnson will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12-8 p.m. Friday.

Mr. Morris Everett "Bud" Johnson was born on June 3, 1935 in Brownsville, Tennessee. He was the second of six children born to the marital union of Booker and Amelia Johnson. He grew up on a farm and worked hard doing family chores and farm work during his early years. He graduated from Carver High School (formerly Haywood County Training School). After graduating from high school, in an effort to secure a better economic life he moved to Flint, Michigan and began working at General Motors. After working there for 47 years he retired from the Grand Blanc plant. Growing up in a Christian home Morris was baptized into Christ at an early age at the Beech Grove Church of Christ in Brownsville, Tennessee. In recent years he has been active in attendance at the North Central Church of Christ in Flint. Morris was married to Hazel Gray-Johnson (deceased), and to that union two children were born: Cheryl and Belinda. He was later married to Florida Mae "Jackie"

McAfee-Johnson (deceased). No children were born to that union. He married Armanda Teamer-Johnson in 2010 and they remained married until his death. Morris was a jokester and could keep you laughing for hours with his stories about growing up and real life situations. He loved dogs and was an avid hunter. He was affectionately known as "Coon Man" by some of his closest friends. He also loved gardening and could be seen delivering greens, corn and other vegetables to those he knew. His hobbies included CB radio, where he carried the handle of "Yo Yo (unit 206)".
