MILLER, Mother Mattie Mae - Age 89, passed away Wednesday, June 9, 2010 at her residence. Family hour 10:30 a.m. Wednesday, June 16, 2010 at New Jerusalem Full Gospel Baptist Church, 1035 E. Mother Mattie Mae Miller was born August 29, 1920 in Sunflower, Mississippi, the oldest child of Lemmie Hearndon (Davis) and Eli Weathersby. Mother Miller departed this life after "89" years on June 9, 2010. After marrying her husband Eddie Miller "Pete" in 1942 they relocated to Flint, where they remained married for 49 years until his departure from this life on May 1, 1991. Mother Miller was a former member of New Jerusalem Full Gospel Baptist Church and later joined Shiloh Missionary Baptist Church. She was soon appointed to the Mother's Board and was a faithful member until her illness. Mother Miller enjoyed playing BINGO, fishing, traveling with her family as well as with her church family. She was always ready to go!!! Her very special "gift" was making personalized quilts, unique and straight from her heart. Mother Miller loved to kid with people and was a joy to be around.
