PERKINS, Mother Deborah (Phinisee) - Age 77, went home to be with her Heavenly Father, Friday, July 22, 2011 at Hurley Medical Center. Family hour 11 a.m. Saturday July 30, 2011 at Grace Emmanuel Baptist Church, 3502 Lapeer Rd., with funeral service commencing at 12Noon Rev. Marvin Jennings, Host Pastor, Supt. Mother Perkins will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, and may be viewed from 1-8 p.m. Friday. Mother Perkins was born August 15, 1933 in Darlove, Mississippi, the daughter of Elder Cleveland and Mother Isabell Phinisee. She accepted Christ at an early age at the Church of God in Hollandale, MS under the leadership of Bishop T.J. Bell. Mother Perkins met and married Solomon Perkins, Jr. on January 19, 1953 and remained married until his death in 1997. They moved to Flint, MI and united with New Covenant C.O.G.I.C. under the leadership of Elder Felix Earley. Mother Perkins was currently a faithful member of Civic Heights C.O.G.I.C. under the leadership of Supt. Samuel Marsh, where she served as Church Mother, Junior Choir Leader, Sunday School, Purity Class and YWCC Teacher. She also served in the Outreach Department of the church. Mother Perkins enjoyed baking, gardening and helping anyone in need. She was a true example of a "Virtuous Woman" as described in Proverbs 31.
