



## Mr. Naaman Ford

September 6, 1948 - December 26, 2013

FORD, Mr. Naaman - Age 65, passed away Thursday, December 26, 2013 at Jacobs Ladder Assisted Living-Grand Blanc. Family hour 9:30 a.m. Friday, January 3, 2014 at Family Worship Center Church International, 3280 N. Linden Rd. with funeral service commencing at 10 a.m. Pastor Timothy R. Mr. Naaman Ford was born September 6, 1948, in Fort Wayne, IN, the son of Eddie Lee Ford, Sr. and Gladys (Hardnett) Ford. His early childhood years were spent in Gary, IN before moving to Flint, MI, where he attended Flint Public Schools graduating from Northwestern High School in 1966. Naaman entered the U.S. Army in May of 1968 where he completed Radio Relay Carrier Attendant Training and afterwards was assigned to serve overseas in Germany. He received an Honorable Discharge from the army in July of 1970 and was also awarded the National Defense Service Medal. Naaman was a dedicated employee and worked at the General Motors Chevrolet V-8 Engine Plant until his early retirement. Mr. Ford was also owner and operator of his home-based business "Naaman's Tax Service." Naaman married Paula (Johnson) Ford in 1976, and received the joy of his life when his treasured

son, Naaman Kiah Ford was born. After accepting Christ into his life he became a member of Family Worship Center Church where he faithfully served as an Usher until his health declined. Naaman was a man of many talents and he had a genuine love for people, especially his family and friends. His generosity and helpful nature was apparent to everyone he encountered and he showed it through his deeds. He was a devoted and loving father, a cherished brother, a “favorite” uncle, and so much more. Naaman’s distinguished, one of a kind, chuckle will also forever remain etched in the minds and hearts of his family and friends.
