Mother Erma Nadine Housley-March was born December 17, 1933 in Peno, Oklahoma the third child of William and Joe Erma Housley. She was a resident of Spring, Texas. Mother March grew up in Flint and attended the Flint Public Schools graduating from Flint Central High School. She was employed at Hurley Medical Center as a Nursing Assistant and retired after working 25 years. Mother March later relocated to Spring, Texas to be closer to her children. After moving to Texas she joined the Lakewood Church under the leadership of Pastor Joel Osteen. For the love that she had for people and their well care, she continued her Nursing Care Assistance in Texas for a while. Mother March would return back to Flint once or twice a year to be with family and to help care for her father who lived to be 104 years old. She was a member of Living Word Ministry while in Flint, and there she served as a Greeter and was also active in other areas of the church. Mother Housley loved to go to church. During the 1950's she became a member of the Gospel

Highlights of Macedonia. She loved listening to gospel music especially quartets. The Williams Brothers and the Canton Spirituals were her favorite. Mother March enjoyed watching the Food Network Channel, yard work, crochet, cooking and spending time with her family both in Texas and Michigan.
