



Deacon Napoleon Moore

MOORE, Deacon Napoleon - Age 86, passed away Monday, February 17, 2020 at his residence. Family hour 10:00 AM Wednesday, February 26, 2020 at First Union Baptist Church, 7004 Fleming Rd., with funeral service commencing at 11:00 AM Pastor Archie Powell, Jr. Host Pastor. Interment Sunset Hills Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10:00 AM Wednesday. Deacon Moore will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12:00 PM - 8:00 PM Tuesday.

Deacon Napoleon Moore was born October 2, 1933 in Stallo, Mississippi, one of sixteen children born to Wilson and Callie Moore. Napoleon attended Public School in Stallo and Philadelphia, MS and graduated from Hopewell High School. After graduating from high school, he enlisted in the United States Army serving for 2 years and was Honorably Discharged in 1955. In 1968, Napoleon met and married Hattie Fitzpatrick and their blended family consisted of 4 children, Olson, Nathaniel, Jezette and Bryant "Keith". Deacon Moore accepted Christ at an early age. He continued his religious journey by being a member at First Union Baptist Church. There he served as Chairman of the Deacon Board until 2018. He also sang in the Voices of First Union Old Folks Choir and the Mighty Male Chorus.

Napoleon was employed at Flint Truck & Bus, a division of General Motors Corporation and retired in 1999 after 42 years of dedicated service. He loved

watching sports, baseball, his favorites were, the Baltimore Orioles and Tiger Woods. Napoleon was a loving husband, father, grandfather and great-grandfather. He also loved his family, singing and working in his yard.
