MOFFETT, Mr. Narvell - Age 59, passed away Thursday, February 14, 2008 at Henry Ford Care Center. Family hour 10AM Tuesday, February 19, 2008 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., with funeral service commencing immediately at 11AM, Bishop Herbert D. Dudley, officiating. Interment Flint Memorial Park Cemetery, G-9506 N. Dort Hwy. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10AM Tuesday. Mr. Moffett will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home. On January 3, 1948 Narvell Moffett Jr., was born to Johnnie Mae Moffett and Narvell Moffett Sr., in Hahira, Georgia. A graduate of Flint Northwestern High School "Class of 1966", he led a blessed life. In 1967 Narvell was drafted into the U.S. Army where he served for 3 years. In the mid-nineties his health began to fail and he retired after 30 years of service from General Motors. Narvell was affectionately known as "Butch". Regardless of how he was known, there is no doubt that he was loved. His sense of humor and direct approach to life reflected joy, strength of character, honesty and truth. "Butch" had an affinity for birds, admiring their ability to take flight and be free. On February 14th, 2008 he, like the birds he admired, took flight making his transition. Narvell leaves to cherish his memory: daughters, Beatriz Moffett and Aleta "Nina" Arthur; father, Narvell Moffett Sr.; one brother, Robert Moffett; two sisters, Dyann (Bobby) Neal and Marilyn Moffett; three grandchildren, Markena, Christina and Carl Arthur IV; five nieces, Yolanda Demps, Tonya Govereh, DaShawna, Dwana and Ashley Moffett; three nephews, John &
